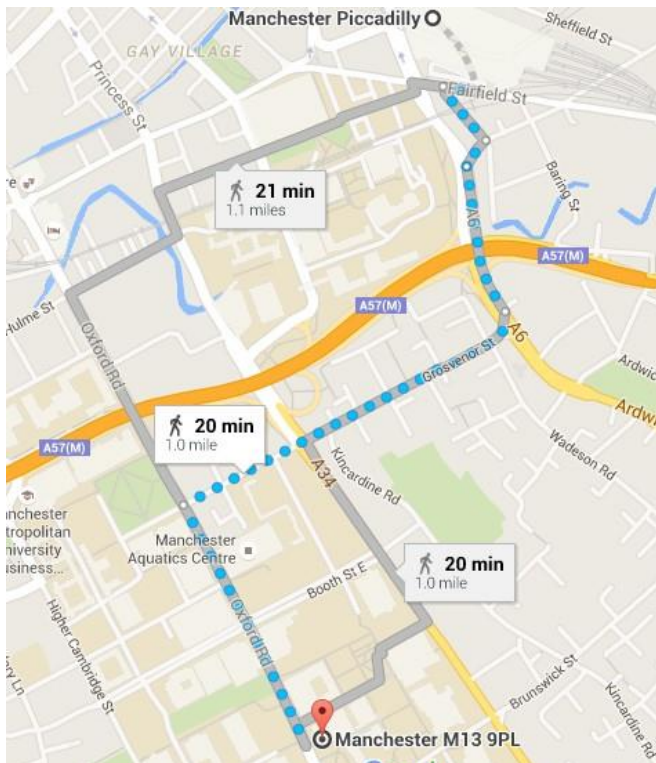
The 2017 conference will be held at the Universities most iconic venue – University Place (the Visitors Centre). It houses the largest lecture theatre in Greater Manchester and has been fitted with the latest technology to give guests a comfortable and seamless experience. 96% of previous guests thought it was a high-quality venue.

It's easy to travel by train to The University of Manchester due to our proximity to three large rail stations.

We are located close to both **Piccadilly** main line station (about two and a half hours from London) and **Oxford Road** train station, with **Victoria** train station being a little further away.

From Manchester Piccadilly Station

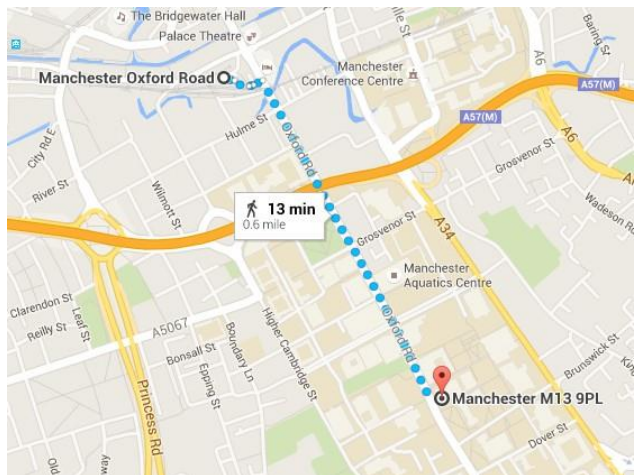


Piccadilly Station to Oxford Road

We're in close proximity to the main Piccadilly train station. To walk will approximately take 20-25 minutes, alternatively busses from from Piccadilly gardens and many services are £1 for a one way ticket.

A taxi from Piccadilly Station to the Oxford Road area of the campus will cost you about £5.

Oxford Road Train Station to Campus

To get to the Oxford Road area of the campus, go down the station approach to Oxford Road and turn right. The campus is a 10- to 15-minute walk.

Alternatively, buses stop outside the Palace Hotel. Many bus operators will provide a one-way journey to the campus for only £1.

Public Transport Services:

- Buses from Piccadilly Bus Station: 14, 16, 41, 42, 43, 43a, 44, 45a, 48, 111, 140, 142, 157, 250.
- Buses from Oxford Road Station: All buses that run along Oxford Road.
- Buses from Cross Street outside Boots the Chemist: 47, 87, 50, 143, 197, 291.
- Buses from Manchester Airport: 43a, 45a.
- Bus from Piccadilly Train Station: 147 (weekdays only).
- Bus from Victoria Station: 42.
- Bus from Shudehill Interchange: 18.
- Tram: Alight at St Peter's Square and walk or catch a bus down Oxford Road.
- Services to the Sackville Street area of the campus include:
 - Tram (Metrolink) – various lines to Piccadilly station, which is a short walk away.
- Buses along London Road: 107, 192, 196, 201, 203, 204, 205, 206, 373.
- Bus along Sackville Street: 140.

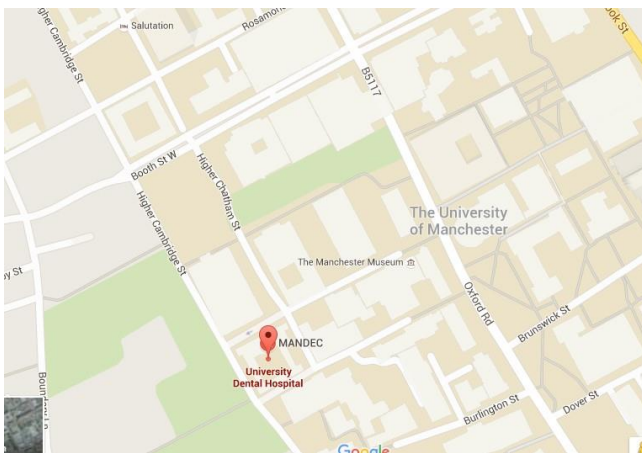

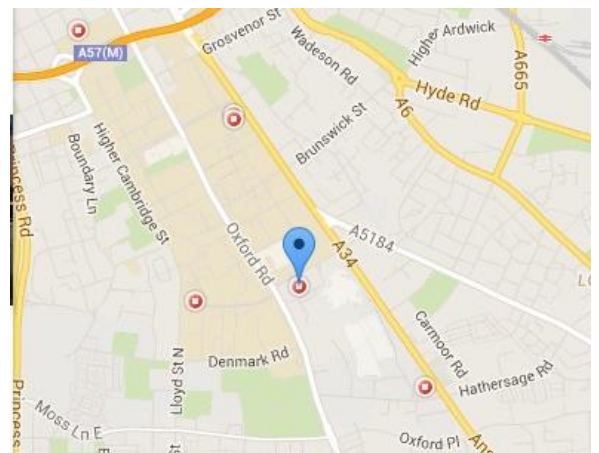
