REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Open to all UK undergraduate BDS and hygiene and therapy students.
- 2) Eligible clinical cases include procedures completed on patients only, not on phantom heads.
- 3) Submit photos and up to 300 words describing the case to **info@mudrsoc.com** before the deadline of **5PM** on **12th January 2024**.
- 4) Include your full name, university and year in the email body.
- 5) Cases from all specialities are permitted, including but not limited to restorative, oral surgery and paediatrics.
- 6) If patient photographs are used, then consent must have been obtained.
- 7) The case must be the participant's work during their time at dental school. Any external contribution, such as by tutors, must be credited.



WHAT TO EXPECT:

- 1) Participants will be notified of the outcome during the BUDRC on 17th February 2024.
- 2) Three successful participants will be selected.
- 3) These 3 finalists will be asked to:
 - ↳ Create a poster based on their clinical case which will be displayed during the British Undergraduate Dental Research Conference on Saturday 17th February 2024.
 - ↳ Orally present their case live during the morning of the BUDRC. This should be accompanied by a digital version of their clinical case poster (on PowerPoint) and will last no longer than 5 minutes followed by a short Q&A by the judges.
- 4) The winning clinical case poster presentation will be selected by the judges and will receive a prize.
- 5) All finalists are expected to buy a ticket for the conference and be able to attend all day.
- 6) All finalists will receive certificates.
